

CALL FOR ENTRIES

Show Rules

1. Eligibility: Open to all Colorado Artists
2. Theme: 2-D and 3-D artwork that incorporates anything with a literal or implied "inside and outside," in other words a "container"
3. When: AUGUST 19 – SEPTEMBER 5, 2010
4. Location: CORE: New Art Space Annex, 900 Santa Fe Drive, Denver, CO 80204
5. Media: Any wall-hung or pedestal fine art medium
6. Entries: Each artist may enter up to 3 original works in digital format on CD, 72 dpi jpg with maximum dimensions of 1024 x 768 or 768 x 1024 pixels
7. Fee: \$10 for one entry, or \$25 for up to 3 entries. Checks payable to WCA/CO. If you join WCA/CO for \$60, you can enter 3 pieces for \$10
8. Specifications: Wall works must be dry, framed or have wrapped edges with staples visible only on the back. Works must be ready for hanging with screw-eyes and wire – no saw-tooth or clip hangers. Label with Artist's name, phone number & title of work on back. Label sculptures on back or bottom. WEIGHT: 25 lbs maximum, SIZE: 24 x 36" maximum
9. Sales: A 30% commission to CORE; New Art Space will be taken on all sales
10. Insurance: No insurance is provided by WCA/CO; WCA/CO is not liable for loss or damage during shipping. Include check/cash/or prepaid label for return shipping.

Call for Entries - Container Show:

2-D and 3-D artwork that incorporates anything with a literal or implied "inside and outside," in other words a "container."

This allows for the inclusion of (or images of) houses, boxes, shrines, drawers, cups, vessels, clothing and even the human body; and interpretive pieces that can venture into ideas of the internal and the external. It also can allow for depictions and questions regarding the container itself and the nature of its separating edge. A variety of mediums, such as painting, printmaking, photography, mixed media, sculpture, ceramics, and handmade books could be included. Artwork can run the gamut from serious and political, to frivolous and whimsical, plus entertain both adult and children's audiences.

A Best of Show and several Honorable Mentions will have their images posted on the WCA Colorado facebook site and the WCA Colorado website.

Juror: Laurie Zuckerman is a painter and found-art assemblage artist, focusing on altar installations and memory jugs since 1992. Her artwork has been exhibited at museums and galleries in Seattle, Spokane, Tacoma, Portland, Eugene; Chicago, Virginia, Tennessee, Taos, Denver, Durango, Loveland, Fort Collins; and Hong Kong. Ms. Zuckerman has been an instructor of Painting and Drawing at Front Range Community College in Fort Collins, since 2000.
