## SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS AND SHOW GUIDELINES

Please read through the WCA-Colorado exhibition guidelines. The Requirements are the standards by which all artwork will be considered for jurying in every WCA show.

### REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMITTING ARTWORK

- + Art must be completed within two years of the show, and not previously shown at the Lakewood Cultural Center.
- + Art must be completely dry, clean, undamaged, professionally finished and ready to display.
- + Wall and suspended art must have suitable means for hanging, including any hanging wire if necessary.
- + No sawtooth hangers.
- + Standing art must be stable.
- + Artwork must be child-friendly, no sexual references.
- + Art must remain in place for the duration of the show.
- + Art need not be for sale.
- + Accepted art may be photographed for publicity or educational purposes. Submission of artwork implies acceptance of photographs being used in this way.
- + Return postage and shipping materials must accompany any submitted artwork. If it is not included, artwork will not be accepted for exhibition. (this applies to submissions from outside the Denver area that won't be directly dropped off/picked up.)

### SIZE RESTRICTIONS

- + Wall pieces can be up to a maximum width of 4' and a maximum height of 6'
- + Sculptural pieces must be 100 lb. or lighter. Heavier pieces will not be accepted.
- + 3d pieces may be up to 5' in height, and 3' in width.

Gallery staff and curator reserve to right of refusal of any artwork entered that does not meet the guidelines above. If a piece arrives that is too large, too heavy, damaged, misrepresented or otherwise unsuitable, it will be returned to the artist.
